Day 1

Arrival

Guided tour to Russell Heights; dinner¹ en route

After check-in you will enjoy an ice-breaking session and then you will be briefed on the memorable, once in a lifetime experience you are about to have.

Day 2

Holywell National Park

Depart for a guided tour through the northern side of the Blue and John Crow



Mountains with stops in Irish Town's Café Blue, Holywell National Park for picnic lunch¹, Section and Chris Blackwell's Strawberry Hills Hotel. Depart for dinner¹ in Kingston and return to Russell Heights.

Days 3-4

Blue Mountain Sunrise

Depart for the Blue Mountains with overnight stop in the District of Penlyne



Castle. Enjoy a little tour of the coffee farm in the area and get ready for a fantastic view of the sunset. After dinner¹ we rest in preparation for our 1:00 am hike to the highest point in Jamaica for a view of the magnificent sun rise. Return to Penlyne Castle for breakfast¹ and then depart for Russell Heights.

Non-hikers will enjoy a plantation tour as well as a tour of the community and will be able to view the sun rise from the viewing area at the lodge while enjoying the cool and misty Blue Mountains air.

Day 5

A Day at the Beach

Spend the day relaxing on the beach where you will be served a sumptuous lunch of



Escoveitched fish¹ and festivals¹, a Jamaican beach favourite if you so choose this lunch option. Return to the hotel and get ready to go on the town for an evening of live entertainment² and a sumptuous dinner¹ with the option to experience real Jamaican night life at one of the many night clubs² in town.

Day 6 Kaleidoscope of Portland

Depart Russell Heights for a visit to the beautiful parish of Portland for a



kaleidoscopic view of the town. Here we will have the best jerked food¹ on the island, visit the Jamaica Palace and take a peek at the only Castle in the Caribbean. The Blue Lagoon is just around the corner for viewing and photos. We then move on to Frenchman's Cove for swimming and relaxation and then we head back to Kingston for dinner¹.

Day 7 Dunn's River Falls and Walking Tour

A visit to Jamaica's most famous visitor attraction - the stunning Dunn's River Falls²



and Beach is next on the agenda. This experience offers a climb up the waterfalls from the beach, right to the top, stopping on the way to enjoy the cool plunge pools formed **naturally** in the river rocks and the waterfalls which are gentle in some places and thunderous in others. Refreshing and invigorating is

how you will describe the experience at the end of it all.

After Lunch¹, enjoy a walking tour of Ocho Rios and indulge in some shopping for some of the finest craft items in the island. Visit Taj Mahal and Island Village for shopping with a difference. Stroll through Turtle River Park and then head on down to the Craft Village in the town square for souvenir shopping. The old Georgian clock tower which lies just beyond the craft village is the marker for navigating the busy thoroughfare of Ocho Rios when you go on your 2 hour free run of the town. You will enjoy reggae music and learn a little of our dialect, as you get up close and personal with hundreds of vendors and shoppers.

Dinner¹ is next then we depart for Kingston.

Day 8 Kingston City Tour

Visit [Port Royal](#) – once known as the “richest and wickedest city in the world”.



Visit the tomb of Lewis Galdy who was swallowed up in the 1692 earthquake and miraculously thrown out to sea by another shock, then we move on to Fort Charles, one of the 6 forts that guarded the town; here you will “walk in the footsteps” of Henry Morgan and Admiral Nelson as your local guide brings the experience to life. Leaving the Fort we take you through to

Victoria and Albert's Battery for a stunning experience in the Giddy House and then on to view the remains of the 1880's gun pits which are interconnected by tunnels.

Lunch¹ at Gloria's will be among the best Fried Fish Experience you will encounter.

After lunch we visit the [Bob Marley Museum](#)², home of world renowned Super Star Robert "Bob" Nesta Marley and one of Kingston's most visited attractions with sightseeing en route: Parliament, Heroes Circle, Simon Bolivar's Statue, Bob Marley's Statue - National Stadium. Tour the compound and museum, take advantage of souvenirs in the gift shop and then move on to our next place of interest – Devon House² an 1886 Mansion built by Jamaica's first Millionaire. Tour the mansion, enjoy some of Jamaica's best Ice Cream "*Devon House Ice Cream*"¹ and do some more shopping.



Return to Russell Heights after dinner¹.
